

Privacy Policy

Protecting your private information is our priority. This Statement of Privacy applies to <https://www.modernacts.org>, and Modern Acts and governs data collection and usage. For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to Modern Acts include <https://www.modernacts.org> and Modern Acts. The Modern Acts website is a news, information, and volunteer portal site. By using the Modern Acts website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

In order to better provide you with products and services offered, Modern Acts may collect personally identifiable information, such as your:

- First and Last Name
- Mailing Address
- E-mail Address
- Phone Number

If you purchase Modern Acts's products and services, we collect billing and credit card information. This information is used to complete the purchase transaction.

Please keep in mind that if you directly disclose personally identifiable information or personally sensitive data through Modern Acts's public message boards, this information may be collected and used by others.

We do not collect any personal information about you unless you voluntarily provide it to us. However, you may be required to provide certain personal information to us when you elect to use certain products or services. These may include: (a) registering for an account; (b) entering a sweepstakes or contest sponsored by us or one of our partners; (c) signing up for special offers from selected third parties; (d) sending us an email message; (e) submitting your credit card or other payment information when ordering and purchasing products and services. Use of your Personal Information

Modern Acts collects and uses your personal information to operate and deliver the services you have requested.

Modern Acts may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from Modern Acts and its affiliates.

Sharing Information with Third Parties

Modern Acts does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties.

Modern Acts may, from time to time, contact you on behalf of external business partners about a particular offering that may be of interest to you. In those cases, your unique personally identifiable information (e-mail, name, address, telephone number) is not transferred to the third party.

Modern Acts may share data with trusted partners to help perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to Modern Acts, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

Tracking User Behavior

Automatically Collected Information

Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by Modern Acts. Right to Deletion

Subject to certain exceptions set out below, on receipt of a verifiable request from you, we will:

- Delete your personal information from our records; and
- Direct any service providers to delete your personal information from their records.

Please note that we may not be able to comply with requests to delete your personal information if it is necessary to:

- Complete the transaction for which the personal information was collected, fulfill the terms of a written warranty or product recall conducted in accordance with federal law, provide a good or service requested by you, or reasonably anticipated within the context of our ongoing business relationship with you, or otherwise perform a contract

- between you and us;
- Detect security incidents, protect against malicious, deceptive, fraudulent, or illegal activity; or prosecute those responsible for that activity;
 - Debug to identify and repair errors that impair existing intended functionality;
 - Exercise free speech, ensure the right of another consumer to exercise his or her right of free speech, or exercise another right provided for by law;
 - Comply with the California Electronic Communications Privacy Act;
 - Engage in public or peer-reviewed scientific, historical, or statistical research in the public interest that adheres to all other applicable ethics and privacy laws, when our deletion of the information is likely to render impossible or seriously impair the achievement of such research, provided we have obtained your informed consent;
 - Enable solely internal uses that are reasonably aligned with your expectations based on your relationship with us;
 - Comply with an existing legal obligation; or
 - Otherwise use your personal information, internally, in a lawful manner that is compatible with the context in which you provided the information.

Children Under Thirteen

Modern Acts does not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from children under the age of thirteen. If you are under the age of thirteen, you must ask your parent or guardian for permission to use this website.
